

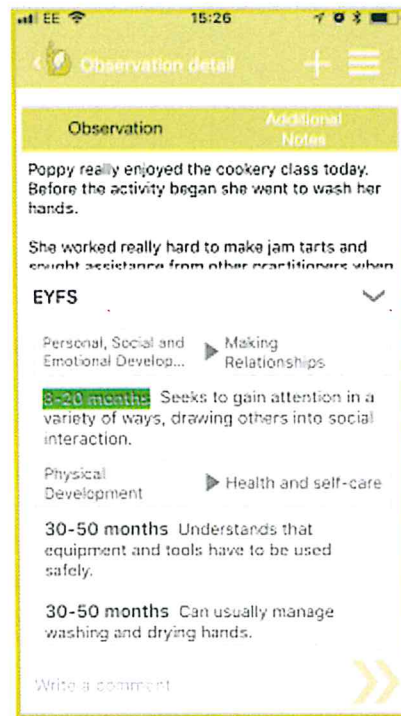
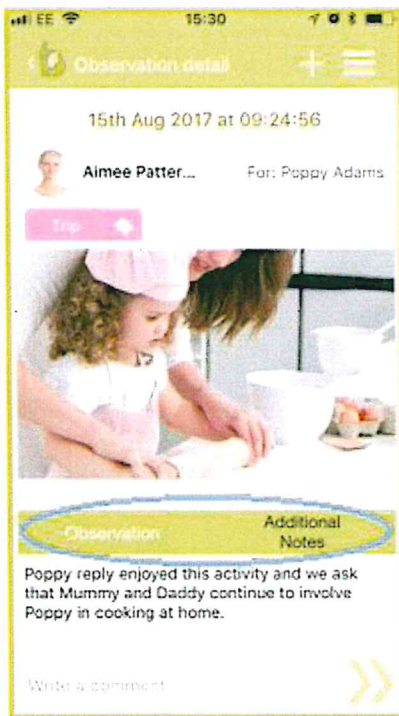

Dear Parents and Carers,

The use of Eylog in our setting has shown a proven, positive impact on our assessment and tracking systems and we hope that you are also able to identify similar benefits of using an electronic assessment tool to track your child's progress.

Following our own review and to further enhance its impact, we have provided Eylog with practitioner feedback to promote additional improvement. So far parents have not been able to see the progress their child is making with regards to the observations that are submitted to them and so we have resolved this problem with Eylog. You will now be able to access this information and in order to help understand the assessment levelling system on Eylog, we have included some further contextual information for you below:

The assessment section underneath the observation tabs show the details of the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) assessment(s) added to the observation, while the assessment level indicates how your child is progressing within a learning aspect.



EYFS assessment levels will appear in the coloured boxes below each observation, this will normally be highlighted in grey, orange or green (please see key below) to enable you to determine if your child is emerging, developing or secure within that area of development.
