## Judo

The Olympic Sport of Judo is not only great for keeping your child fit, it's also brilliant fun as well! Thousands of children all across Britain take part in the sport of Judo, some in schools and some in clubs. Peter Jones has been practising judo for over 35 years and has been teaching judo for over 20 years in the Wirral. Sessions will be for children from Reception to Year 6. Peter provides all the equipment, the children just need their PE kit. The class will be taught on judo mats in full judo kit. The classes will take place after school on Tuesday. The infant course (Reception – Year 2) is from 3.05pm until 3.35pm and the junior course (Year 3 – Year 6) is from 3.40pm until 4.40pm. The cost of the 8 week course is £2 per lesson (£16) for the infants and £3 per lesson (£24) for the juniors.
