**A reminder to Key Worker parents:**

We do not, and would not, accept Key Worker children who turn up on the day – parents must endeavour to make sure that you communicate requirements for places in school for Key worker children in advance, to enable sufficient staffing provision and to ensure that children can be socially distanced appropriately in their protective bubble groups.
