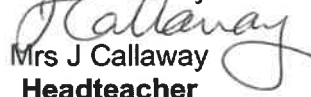
Parents will be expected to wear a mask at all times while attending the event, unless you are exempt, and asked to make use of the hand sanitiser on entering the school site. Parents should arrive as stated below for a prompt 2pm performance start.

Reception class parents should arrive at 1.45pm
Year 1 class parents should arrive at 1.50pm
Year 2 class parents should arrive at 1.55pm

We kindly ask that the children leave with their parents/ carers immediately following the event to enable safe dismissal and collection arrangements to continue as normal, for the remaining classes in school. The children will be dismissed to parents/carers by their class teacher.

Since the end of year celebration will take place outdoors on the playground, our arrangements will be weather dependant. We will, of course, endeavour to inform parents approximately 24 hours prior to the ceremony, should we need to cancel the event due to bad weather. In the event that we need to cancel, we will move the ceremony into the school hall. However, unfortunately we will be unable to invite parents into the school building due to the current restrictions, and as an alternative, we will record the ceremony and share it with parents online.
