# Arrangements for the Summer Term 2021



- The Department for Education updated its operational guidance for Schools on 26<sup>th</sup> March. Arrangements at Avalon for the summer term will continue to follow the DfE guidance.
  - Drop Off and Collection arrangements will continue to be staggered in the same way as they have been during the Spring Term, until further notice.

	<ul> <li>Children will wear their Summer Uniform as normal, with the exception of PE days, when they should come to school in their PE kits to avoid changing in school.</li> <li>Children will continue to be in distinct 'bubble groups' wherever possible, to reduce the risk of transmission.</li> <li>School will continue to follow the system of controls as advised by Public Health England</li> <li>Educational day visits may resume following 12<sup>th</sup> April, subject to stringent risk assessment, however residential visits are not currently permissible.</li> <li>Wraparound &amp; Before &amp; After School Club (Childcare) will continue to run with same timings as in the Spring term. (7.45am- 8.30am and 3pm to 6pm)</li> <li>Parents are not permitted to enter the school site, unless by prior arrangement by appointment.</li> </ul>

# Safer Road Watch Team



The Safer Road Watch Team has been in touch with School regarding their concerns over the speed of car along Caldy Road and the safety implications involved. We have been asked to make our whole school community aware that a group of vetted volunteers will shortly be issued with handheld speed radar guns and will be operating speed checks along Caldy Road. The group is hoping to establish a 20mph speed limit for Caldy Road, something that we have been campaigning for too.



Parents and Carers, please ensure that you queue to the boundary wall side when dropping off or collecting children (so as not to block the full pavement width) and please keep social distancing, in the interests of everyone's health and safety. Thank you.

#### **Sibling Drop Off and Collection**




Staggered bubble group drop off and collection times are in place during drop off and collection to help reduce the risks of transmission of COVID-19.
