However, due to the current COVID-19 situation we have taken the decision to hold online Parent Information Meetings this year delivered via Zoom video conferencing.

The date and time of your child's meeting is as follows:

Nursery and Pre-school – Monday 20th September at 4pm.

The Meeting ID and Password will be sent to you via email, prior to your online meeting.



Individual and sibling pupil photographs will be taken on Thursday 30th September in the morning. All children will have an individual photograph taken and siblings will have a group photograph taken also. Children should attend school in their smart winter uniform including blazers.

Parents/Carers of children who do not attend Nursery or Pre-School on a Thursday but would like their child to have their photograph taken, we would be grateful if you could arrive at Nursery for 9.30am. Parents/Carers must stay on the site while the photograph is taken.

Photographs will be available to order via the photograph company, details of which will be sent home with the children along with photograph proofs.

Year 5 Children must come into school wearing their Winter uniform and they will then change into their PE kit after their photograph has been taken.

Start of Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.


Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.
