Reception Class Diwali Food Tasting Friday 5th November



The children in Reception Class held a mini celebration on Friday 5th November as part of their learning about Diwali which involved the children trying some of the traditional foods enjoyed at the family feast such as pakoras, samosas and bhaji.

The children created their own Diya lamps, made Rangoli patterns and celebrated away in our party area!





We have children within our school who have very severe and potentially life-threatening food allergies to several ingredients and foods including all nuts and sesame seeds.

The food allergies are severe and exposure in any form (skin contact or ingestion) to these substances could result in anaphylaxis, a potentially fatal condition that requires immediate medical attention.

We must ask that **only** healthy snacks such as fruit or vegetables should be brought into school. Please note, that crisps are not deemed as a healthy snack. Please also instruct your child to not share food with other classmates.

Our "Nut-Free Policy" means that the following items should not be brought into school:

- Packs of nuts
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Cakes or pastries made with nuts
- Pretzels or similar

We know that many parents like to celebrate birthdays and other occasions with special treats. We encourage parents to celebrate with non-food items such as stickers, pencils, themed erasers, or other trinkets, rather than food.

Parents Evening Online Consultations Letter

Reception to Year 6 Flu Immunisation – E-consent Friday 12th November



Wirral NHS will be offering all children from reception to year 6 a flu nasal spray immunisation on Friday 12th November, in school. Parents who wish for their child to have the immunisation must complete an online consent form.

You can now provide electronic-consent (e-Consent) for **all** your child's vaccinations with a click of a button, using your mobile phone, computer, laptop or tablet.

So how does the process work?

- the form is simple and easy to complete
- once you've completed the form click 'submit'
- you'll receive an email to confirm the form has been received securely
- the Trust's Immunisation Team will receive your child's form via a secure portal
- if you've consented, your child will have their vaccine in school.

Chester Zoo Thursday 18th November

Start of Day Arrangements




Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.

End of the School Day


