Year 4 Residential Monday 15th May – Tuesday 16th May 2017

We have reserved places for children in year 4 to take part in 2 activity days in Delamere Outdoor Activity Centre in Delamere Forest. You can find more about the centre here: http://www.conwaycentres.co.uk/delamere-forest/

The visit is booked for 15th and 16th May The children will come to school as normal on 15th May and be taken by coach to Delamere Forest.

Originally known as Foxhowl, the building used to be a Youth Hostel and it is well known for its homely appeal. Available within the grounds is a well-established nature pond. There is safe access to Delamere Forest where children can participate in activities such as orienteering, den building, survival skills, stream dipping, environmental games, forest art and walks which study animal habitats and the different flora and fauna of the forest. Within the grounds there is an ascent wall which is used for problem solving and team building. The woodland environment surrounding the Centre provides a wealth of opportunities to enrich a school-based curriculum.

The aims of the residential are:

- Learning new skills
- · Gaining an appreciation of the natural environment
- Exciting activities
- Developing an awareness of the needs of others
- Meeting personal challenges

There is a large sized games room at our disposal throughout our stay for indoor activities or study and facilities for wet weather. There is also an adventure playground for the children to use. We will have sole use of the centre and its facilities for the visit. Food is prepared and served on site with cereal and a cooked breakfast available. There is a full packed lunch with fruit and a drink and a cooked 3 course meal in the evening. There will also be a light supper of hot chocolate, biscuits and other treats. Special diets are catered for.

As part of the activity programme, the children will participate in numerous activities in and around the site. All these activities are provided by the centre and are delivered in conjunction with our teachers. They are very education centered with a focus on team building and problem solving whilst being exciting and adventurous.
