Pre-Shool and Reception Visit to Ness Gardens Tuesday 3rd May 2022



As part of the Pre-School and Reception class topic about Spring and Growth, an educational visit to Ness Botanic Gardens has been booked on Tuesday 3rd May 2022. We hope the visit to the gardens will enhance the children's learning about caring for our planet and local environment whilst extending their knowledge and understanding of the world.

The cost of the trip will be £15.25 which will include the cost of the coach, entry to the gardens and workshop. The coach, (fitted with seatbelts), will set off from school at approximately 9.30am, please ensure your child arrives to school in plenty of time so we can organise ourselves for departure. School will be providing the children with a packed lunch including a drink, which will be eaten at the gardens. We should arrive back at school in time for normal pick up at 3.00pm.

Children are required to wear their school PE kit (school long track pants rather than shorts or skorts) on the day and wellington boots are essential. Please could we ask that all children bring with them a small rucksack to carry their lunch in. There will be no need for the children to bring any spending money. In order to simplify the arrangements of trips, we will allocate a place for your child and the cost of £15.25, will be added to your next invoice. To enable your child to attend the trip to the Ness Botanic Gardens it is important that the consent form is completed and returned to the school office no later than Monday 25th April 2022.

Year 6 Residential – Tattenhall Centre Tuesday 3rd to Friday 6th May



We have reserved places for a Year 6 residential to the Tattenhall Centre in Cheshire in May 2022. As you will no doubt be aware, we have not been able to run residentials for the previous two years and although the current guidance is for trips to be able to run, if there is any change in guidance in the upcoming weeks then we may need to review our preparations.

All the staff at the centre are suitably qualified to instruct the various activities and all specialist equipment is provided by the centre. The total cost of the visit will be £330 and this will include the cost of all travel, meals, insurances, accommodation, all activities and the use of the facilities. We would like all children to attend the residential as we believe it forms an important part of their social development and will also develop skills in numerous areas including Outdoor Adventurous Activities, which is part of the P.E. curriculum.

We ask that a deposit of £110 is payable to the school office by **Monday 28th February 2022** and that the balance of £220 is paid either in full by **25th April 2022** or instalments of:





IMPORTANT REMINDER Breaktime Snack



We have a number of children in Avalon School with severe allergies. It is vitally important to ensure the health and safety of all the children that only fruit, and vegetables are brought into school for break time snacks.

We have also noticed recently that children are bringing in break time snacks to school which are high in salt, sugar and fat such as salted popcorn, crisps, and other sugary snacks. These snacks are not appropriate to brought into school.

Arriving Late to School



For safeguarding purposes, can we please remind parents that if your child is going to be late for school, that you bring your child to the school office so we can ensure that your child has been signed in.

Start of the Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.50am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.

Late attendance (after 8.50am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.




