Dear Parents & Children.

## Year 4 and 5 Adventure Day 2022

As you know, we have reserved places for our Year 4 and 5 children to have an adventure day in Delamere Forest, Cheshire, on Thursday 26th May 2022.

We have booked places on the "Go Ape" Tree Top Adventure Course which is a high ropes course through the trees at Delamere Forest. You can find out more here https://goape.co.uk/locations/delamere/tree-topadventure. We are then taking part in a large problem solving activity called "Baboonzled!"

Children will need to come to school at normal time on Thursday 26th and the bus to Delamere will be leaving at 9am. Children should come to school in the morning dressed ready for the outdoors. They should ensure that they have their PE kits on with their house t-shirts. Trainers will be suitable for the activities that we have planned but children may wear walking shoes or boots. Wellies or similar will not be suitable.

Children should also have a waterproof jacket with them, either coming to school wearing it or in their bags if weather allows. Similarly, if the weather is sunny, children should ensure that they are wearing appropriate sun block for the day. A packed lunch will be provided for the children by school but children should ensure that they bring a water bottle with them. Children should not bring any sweets nor additional food with them. If a child needs to take prescribed medication during the day, please could you ensure that this is taken to the school office on arrival at school, as children should not, under any circumstances, carry medication in their bags.

Children will need a small backpack for the day which they will carry their lunch, water bottle and waterproof jacket in. Children will not need any money, nor should they bring any valuables.

The bus from Delamere will arrive back in plenty of time for a normal end to the school day. Throughout our day there, staff will be posting photographs of the group on the school twitter page @avalonschwirral so you can see how they are getting on!

Attached to this letter is a risk acknowledgement and disclaimer form that has been provided to us by Go Ape. It is very important that parents read it very carefully and a signed form must be returned to school to ensure that your child can participate in the activities.
