Thursday 24 May – Friday 25 May 2018

We have reserved places for children in year 4 to take part in 2 activity days in Forest Camp Activity Centre in Delamere Forest which is owned and operated by Cheshire Scouts. You can find more about the centre here:

The visit is booked for **24th and 25th May** the children will come to school as normal on 24th May and be taken by coach to the centre.

The centre is owned and operated by Cheshire Scouts and has undergone recent extensive redevelopment. The woodland environment surrounding the Centre provides a wealth of opportunities to enrich a school-based curriculum. We have booked a number of adventurous activities for the children such as climbing, low ropes courses, den building, indoor caving and rafting. All these activities are provided by the centre and are delivered in conjunction with our teachers. They are very education centred with a focus on team building and problem solving whilst being exciting and adventurous.

The aims of the residential are :

- Learning new skills
- Gaining an appreciation of the natural environment
- Exciting activities
- Developing an awareness of the needs of others
- Meeting personal challenges

There is a large sized games room at our disposal throughout our stay for indoor activities or study and facilities for wet weather. There is also an adventure playground for the children to use. We will have sole use of the centre and its facilities for the visit. There is a full packed lunch with fruit and a drink and a cooked meal in the evening. There will also be a light supper of hot chocolate, biscuits and other treats. Special diets are catered for.


