
Thursday 14th December to Monday 8th January

Avalon School PE Kit



It has been brought to our attention from a number of parents recently, that there seems to be a sizing / fit issue with the current Avalon PE trousers. We are working with our uniform supplier, Uniformity, to source a better alternative.

However, as it is getting rather cold outdoors and it is unsuitable for children to just be wearing the Avalon PE shorts or skort, we have taken the decision to permit plain black leggings or plain black jogger bottoms to be worn for PE activities, particularly if children are experiencing size / fit issues with the PE trousers.

All other items of regulation uniform and PE kit should be worn as normal. Thank you for your support and co-operation.

Winter School Uniform - Blazers & Coats



We have noticed recently that children are coming into school with non-regulation coats. Please could we ask that children wear their school blazer and their black fleece lined waterproof jacket on top for warmth. Any other coats are not part of the school uniform and therefore should not be worn. Scooters and Bicyles



It is lovely to see children coming to school on their bicycles and scooters in the morning. However please could we ask that bicycles and scooters are not left on the school grounds during the day for safety reasons.

It has come to our attention that there are a number of children wearing earrings in school. Our uniform policy states that for health and safety reasons no jewellery with the exception of a watch may be worn in school.

Therefore, we would be grateful if you could remind children to remove earrings and any other jewellery before coming to school.

We understand that a number of children have only recently had their ears pierced and although it is not ideal, in this instance could we ask parents/carers to ensure that earrings are covered each morning with plasters.

Once the 6-week healing process is complete the earrings should be removed and not worn during school time.

Start of the Day Arrangements



Before school club is from 7.45am to 8.30am. Children attending before school club should enter the hall via the main school glass entrance doors.

From 8.30am to 8.45am parents may drop children off at the school gate which will be manned by Avalon staff. Alternatively parents and carers who may wish to bring their child onto the school site and drop their child off at the allocated entrance doors.

For reception, Year 1 and Year 2, this will be at the main glass entrance doors. For all Junior children, Year 3 to Year 6, this will be at the front door of the junior building.



Late attendance (after 8.45am). If your child is late coming into school, we then ask that parents ring the intercom for assistance and bring their child directly into the school office for registrations.
